Invitation to Applications

The Faculty of Economics and Business Administration of the University of Szeged (hereinafter referred to as 'SZTE GTK') wishes to pay a contribution to the tuition fees payable by students admitted as fee-paying students to the Faculty.

To achieve this objective, the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration offers students in receipt of the scholarship 50% exemption from their tuition fees payable for the Spring Semester of Academic Year 2014/2015.

Applications can be submitted by full-time, fee-paying students admitted to the Faculty's Business Administration and Management undergraduate (BSc) training programme in English who meet the following terms and conditions:

- The number of credits accomplished during his/her studies at SZTE GTK is at least 80.
- The result of his/her mandatory courses in the Autumn Semester of Academic Year 2014/2015 was at least a "Passed."
- If there is a disciplinary decision made against the student, while it is in effect, the student may not apply for a scholarship.

Evaluation Criteria:

- the result, i.e. weighted average of course grades, achieved in the Autumn Semester of Academic Year 2014/2015,
- the documents annexed to the Application Form in the event of equality of points.

The scholarship will be awarded to 1 student.

Documents to be Attached with the Application Form:

- The student's statement of compliance with the terms and conditions of the Invitation to Applications.
- The student's statement that enables the Committee members and the administrators of the application to manage his/her personal details.
- If awarded the scholarship, the student's statement that allows his/her personal details (especially his/her name and major) to be used in the communication of SZTE GTK, his/her statement that allows images and/or sound recordings to be taken of him/her, and that these may be made public through the communication of SZTE GTK.
- The student's statement that he/she shall be available for media purposes regarding the application and the scholarship.
- The student's statement of consent to consult in advance with the appointed representative of SZTE GTK in connection with any media inquiries about the application and the scholarship.
- The student's statement that he/she was not/is not a student in a state-funded/bursary training programme.
- The student's statement that he/she is not subject to a disciplinary penalty.
- The student's statement that the number of credits accomplished during his/her studies at SZTE GTK is at least 80 and that the result of his/her mandatory courses in the Autumn Semester of Academic Year 2014/2015 was at least a "Passed."

A Committee made up of the representatives of SZTE GTK shall be authorised to evaluate the applications. No remedy shall be available against the Committee's decision.

The Invitation to Applications is announced for one semester.

Until a decision is made, the submitted applications shall be archived at SZTE GTK. Pursuant to the Data Handling Policy of the University of Szeged, the applications shall be destroyed after the communication of the results.

The applicants shall be informed electronically by SZTE GTK about the result of the evaluation process.

Deadline of Applications: Midnight of 9 February 2015.

Deficiencies may not be remedied after the announced deadline of receipt of applications.

Deadline of the Evaluation of Applications: 16 February 2015.
